

## **CONTRACT/HEALTH GUARANTEE**

### **TERMS OF SALE**

This contract is the full agreement between the Buyer and Seller of the puppy. This puppy is guaranteed to be in good health to the best of our knowledge at the time of sale, having had a health check by our veterinarian. All puppies are sold with AKC registration papers with limited registration only. Limited registration means the puppy is sold as a pet companion only and is not to be used for breeding.

All puppies come with dewclaws removed, tails docked and age appropriate immunizations and worming's. Buyer is responsible for taking puppy to his/her Veterinarian within 3 working days of receiving the puppy. If puppy is found to be clinically ill or has an illness that was contracted on or before the date of sale, the purchaser and the veterinarian must notify us within 2 days of the veterinarian visit. The puppy and a letter from the examining veterinarian must be returned to the breeder, then the puppy will be checked by our veterinarian to determine if their findings are the same, if so, the purchaser will receive another puppy equal value when available. This guarantee does not cover any illness from exposure to parasites for which it has had preventative treatment while in our care, any disease or handicap resulting from injury or neglect once the puppy has left our premises.

We guarantee our puppies from life-threatening hereditary defects for a period of one year. Buyer must provide written proof from two qualified Veterinarians if a problem is found that poses an imminent threat to the puppy's life to qualify for reimbursement or replacement of the puppy. One Veterinarian is selected by the Seller. Hereditary defects do not include communicable diseases that could be prevented by vaccinations (parvo, distemper, etc.). If puppy should expire within one year, Buyer agrees to pay to have a necropsy performed and any testing of tissues needed to determine cause of death. Seller is not responsible for any kind of worm, Coccidiosis or Giardia, these parasites are common in puppies. The puppy has been wormed frequently from two weeks of age until Buyer takes possession of the puppy. It is Buyer's responsibility to continue to worm the puppy as per veterinarian recommendations. No refund or replacement will be made on a puppy due to illness from neglect, exposure to weather, injury, choking, poisoning, etc.

Occasionally a puppy will be born with an umbilical hernia that normally will close up on its own. Some dogs live their whole lives with small ones that do not need repaired, if it has not closed up on its own by 12 months of age and repair is deemed necessary at that time, Seller will reimburse up to \$25 of the cost of surgery to repair the hernia. Buyer must have documentation from a licensed veterinarian that surgery is medically necessary. Retained testicles are not bound by this guarantee.

This contract is valid only for the original Buyer of the puppy and is not transferable to another person. As stated above, we guarantee our puppies to be in good health as verified by the veterinary health certificate.
